### Directions:

Use the primary source maps to complete the following mapping questions about your delegate's contribution to the Constitutional Convention.

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1. Start with Map 1, "Colonial Map." You will need a ruler.
2. Using your ruler, draw a line approximately from the middle of your delegate's colony to Philadelphia.
3. This will be the approximate distance your delegate had to travel to the constitutional convention. How far?\_\_\_\_\_ in.
4. Now calculate your measurement from #3 into miles using the map scale on the bottom right hand corner.
5. Approximately how far did he have to travel? \_\_\_\_\_ miles.\*\*
