



Additional information

- All Souls Church has a parking lot which will accommodate about 120 cars. These spaces are yours free on a first-come, first-serve basis for the duration of the March. The lot is located to the rear of Fuller Street at 15th St., N.W. 1 block south of the Church. An alternative public parking lot may be used on Columbia Road and Mozart Place, N.W., one block west of 16th Street.
- Sanitation, First aid, etc: March leaders will have comfort stations and first aid stations at the Washington Monument and along the route of the March. Government buildings along Independence and Constitution Avenues will be open for emergencies.
- At All Souls, rest rooms, drinking fountain and a public telephone are in the main hall (15th Street corridor)


