Just a quickee to say that all goes well with R.L.S. I've been out of the hospital for just a week and believe me it's mighty good.

Last Friday I went into LA (illegally) and spent three days with Ronnie and Doug. Had a fine time eating good food, taking it easy, and in general enjoying myself. Had quite a treat when Doug took us out to Warner's where we saw Humphrey Bogart making a new picture. It was really interesting since I'd never been on a movie lot before.
