Even though I wrote you a long letter a day or so ago I thought I'd write a line or two to say that I had Barry over for lunch today. He came over with a couple of friends and I took them to the best chow we've had since we've been down here — believe me they really ate heartly [*sic*], as if they hadn't had a bite to eat in ages. Frankly I hadn't eaten that well in a long time myself. This afternoon I took them all down to the line and we went through a ship and I showed [*strikeout*] [*inserted*:them] all around. Then later on I drove them back to their camp which is only about twenty minutes away.

As I said the other day, Barry is in swell shape and it was fun having him over today. Some time when we're not flying a strike I'm going to try to take him up on a local test hop, if I possibly can.
