July 17th, 1945

Dear Dad and Bee:

There's really nothing new to write about, but I thought you'd be interested to see the enclosed clipping from the morning's paper. Just trying to prove that my complaints about this dump are well founded. Frankly I'll never know how the Air Force ever got stuck with this white elephant when they have such swell places as Atlantic City, Miami, and Santa Monica.

There's nothing new about my assignment, but I ought to know something definite by the end of the week. I've got my fingers crossed that my job at a redistribution or separation center comes through. I'd certainly hate to be sent out to Texas, but I suppose that will be just my luck.

That's about all for now except that I hope you have a swell time at Alderbrook and that you catch lots of trout.
