- 3. "When your mother and your father are having a fight, do you want them to kill each other? Or do you just want them to stop fighting?" How does this quote from *Farewell to Manzanar* exemplify the position that the Issei generation were put in?
- 4. What is the American Dream? How does this book demonstrate the American Dream? Provide examples of either Jeanne, George Ko (dad), Rigu Sakai (mom).
- 5. Based on what you read, did the internment camp have a greater effect on the younger generation or the older generation?
- 6. Many of the people interned were American citizens. Which of their Constitutional rights were denied?
- 7. Jeanne's brother Woody wanted to prove his allegiance to America. Would you ever sign an allegiance to a country, like the one in the book? (Go around the room and answer the question).
- 8. Would you join the military to show your allegiance to a country?
- 9. The 442nd regiment was made entirely of Japanese Americans and was the most highly decorated unit in the war. Why do you think they fought so hard for this country?
- 10. Why did Jeanne return to the camp all those years later?
