
Casualties and Costs of the Civil War

Note: Each figure represents 1%. The Union had 64 enslaved persons as of 1860.








Enslaved African Americans (32.10%)

Free African Americans (2.13%)






Soldier Demographics







Enlistment and Conscription

Official Military Admittance of African American Soldiers*




Troop Fatalities
